It is believed that Jaipur is a city full of colors where every festival is celebrates openly. Talking about Rajasthani food is also the best in itself. People are so passionate about the food of Rajasthan that as long as they are in Rajasthan, they eat Rajasthani food, especially foreigners. There are many such markets in Jaipur that are very famous today. Yes, we are talking about the small Choti-Chopar Market where even today the shops are running. The children of the shopkeepers are growing their business today, doing the same thing. A small leaf store (Pan-Bhandar) that has been turned into 42 years old, still the store is as famous as it was before. Though the living conditions of the people have changed, their taste still remains the same.

In Rajasthan, things are done very well for instance by cutting the drum, people turn it around in which they keeps the stuff in it and sell it. Stuff such as White Patashe, Bura, Jaggery, Makhane and Mishri etc. Tikaram Ji, who has done this kind of work, whose shop has been for 75 years old, is still very good for those things. He works both as wholesale and retail.

In the same way talking about sweets in Rajasthan is also very popular such as Gulab-Jamun, Balushahi, Mishri Mava, Imarti etc. Similarly Samosa, Dal-Kachori, Pyaj -Kachori, Mirchi Vada and Aaloo Vada are very fond of Jaipur. The people of the city use more of these things in breakfast. It can also be called Royal Breakfast.

Jaipur's Artificial Lake 'RAMGARH'

amgarh Lake Jaipur Known for its artificial lake, Ramgarh is situated at a distance of approximately 35 km from Jaipur city. The lake covers an area of 15.5 sq. km and had once been a major source of water for Jaipur city. Ramgarh Lake is a manmade water body created by forming an embankment on the forested hills. The place attracts hundreds and thousands of tourists every year. During monsoons, the lake is flooded with water and presents the most alluring scenic beauty for visitors. It is also an interesting place for bird watchers as they get to see flocks of birds including migratory birds around this artificial lake. Ever since Ramgarh was declared a Wildlife Sanctuary by the Government of India in 1982, the place also offers wildlife safaris for the tourists. There are also polo grounds, Jamwa Mata temple, Old Fort, museum and hunting lodge to see at Ramgarh. Amidst the ruins of ancient forts, Ramgarh Lake makes an ideal picnic spot for the visitors.

History: Ramgarh was once a hunting ground for the Maharajas of Jaipur. Over the years, the place has been

turned into a heritage place. The heritage hotel at Ramgarh now stands majestically overlooking the Ramgarh Lake which is spread across an area of 15.5 sq. kms. Until year 2000, the lake had been a major source of water for the Pink City. Ramgarh Lake has a historical record of hosting a rowing event during 1982 Asian Games. The thick forest near Ramgarh Lake is home to many wildlife species such as Neelgai, Chital and lions. Hence, it has been pronounced a Wildlife Sanctuary since 1982, by the Government of India.

The Highlights of The Place: The artificial Ramgarh Lake, spread across 4km, is the most popular tourist attraction in Ramgarh. The lake offers recreation like boating between the months of October and June. The Polo ground at Ramgarh is regarded as one of the best Polo grounds in India. It is located between Ramgarh Lake and the Aravalli Hills. Jamwa Mata temple is another major attraction for the tourists in Ramgarh. The temple is situated at a downward course of Ramgarh Lake. It was built by Rao Dulherao of the Kachhwaha clan of laipur.

ELEPHANT VILLAGE

Mohammad Ehsaan who has been doing elephant business from last seven years. This is their family business. Their personal contact is with elephant. He said Elephants recognize their body's smell and begin to get good contact with them. All elephants are given different names. When the elephant sells it, then the name of that elephant is in the document.

Normally cold and summer cuisine of elephants is different. They need water every little bit in the summer and if seen in winter, water is required four to five times a day. Elephants always raise three kinds of sounds. Like when he feels some good or bad or when the elephant is angry. We can detect by the elephant's body and their trunk, whether he is hungry or thirsty. With their sounds we understand what they want. The cost of an elephant is 3000-3500 per day. Everyday 300 to 400 Indian and Foreigners visit here.

Earlier this was under the supervision of the Tourist Department. And now it is under the forest department. Entry tickets are different and activities are also provided such as feeding, painting etc. We use the turmeric vegetables colors above the Elephant. We use the same color as suit the elephant's body. The artwork of lions, leaf and birds etc. is done on the body of Elephant. Mostly painting is done on the trunk of elephant. Doctor's team comes for elephant home-age every week and every elephants gets a proper treatment. Ayurvedic medicines are given to elephants.

There a pond where elephants are bathed and the food are provided near the pond. There is a lot of quiet atmosphere over there. These elephant does not harm any visitors. The facility of stay is also provided there. Greenery is very good there. The Indian chickens and Chinese chickens are seen.
